

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, PRESTON CITY AREA) (REVOCATION AND
INTRODUCTION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 20 January 2023 and 17 February 2023, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

Remove Item (5) South Meadow Lane, from Schedule 10.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this modification is to remove the proposed Mixed BG1 Permit Holder Only and Limited Waiting Parking Bay on the north side of South Meadow Lane following feedback in relation to the formal consultation with regards to concerns that the carriageway on South Meadow Lane at this location does not support parking on both sides.

This proposal will maintain the proposed Prohibition of Waiting at the access/egress to the car park along with the proposed BG1 Permit Holder Only Bay outside the residential properties, whilst allowing sufficient carriageway width for larger vehicles to pass.
