NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, PRESTON CITY AREA) (REVOCATION AND INTRODUCTION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 20 January 2023 and 17 February 2023, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

1. Amend Schedule 19 as follows:

- a) Amend the Schedule title to Pay and Display Parking 8am 6pm Max Stay 2 Hours No Return within 2 Hours;
- b) Remove Items (4)b)(ii) Cross Street and (6) Guildhall Street;
- c) Add the following Items:

(4)	Cross Street, Preston b) The south side From a point 29 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Chaddock Street for a distance of 12.5 metres in a westerly direction	Max Stay 2 Hours No Return Within 2 Hours
(6)	Guildhall Street, Preston The east side From a point 16.5 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 37 metres in a northerly direction	Max Stay 2 Hours No Return Within 2 Hours

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this modification is to introduce a 2 hour tariff to the Preston City Centre Pay and Display following objections and feedback in relation to the formal consultation to introduce Sunday charges.

This proposal will facilitate short stay parking provisions for visitors to the city centre and a sufficient time period for people to practice their religion at the number of places of worship around the city centre whilst not impeding on the long stay parking provisions provided by the city centre car parks.

This modification is also to reduce the proposed Pay and Display parking bays on Guildhall Street and Cross Street following feedback from a local resident/business relating to access/egress to private off-street parking areas. These modifications will allow sufficient manoeuvring space for vehicles to gain access to and from the parking area.
