NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this modification is to amend the proposed BG1 Permit Holder Only area on Lauderdale Street, Grafton Street and Hind Street to include BG1 Permit Holders or Limited Waiting 1 Hour No Return Within 1 Hour. This proposal will facilitate parking for customers to the local shop along with short term parking for visitors to the residents of the area.
