

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, PRESTON CITY AREA) (REVOCATION AND
INTRODUCTION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 20 January 2023 and 17 February 2023, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

Remove the Eligible Properties for West Cliff 68-Parkinson House in WC1.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this modification is to amend the advertised eligibility due to an administrative error in the original proposal.

The modification will have the following effect:

Remove 68-Parkinson House as a residential property from the WC1 Eligibility as confirmation has been received that the property is commercial.
