

**NOTICE OF MODIFICATION**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(VARIOUS ROADS, PRESTON CITY AREA) (REVOCAION,**  
**PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, PROHIBITION OF**  
**LOADING, LIMITED WAITING PARKING PLACES AND DISABLED**  
**PARKING PLACES) ORDER 202\***



**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 20 January 2023 and 17 February 2023, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

1. Remove Item pp) Church Avenue from Schedule 2 – Prohibition of Waiting.

**Statement of Reasons**

The purpose of this modification is to remove the proposed Prohibition of Waiting on the northern end of Church Avenue following feedback from local businesses relating to short term customer parking. The removal of this proposal will revert the area back to unrestricted parking allowing parking for visitors to the businesses located on New Hall Lane at the junction with Church Avenue.
