

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, PRESTON CITY AREA) (REVOCAION,
PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, PROHIBITION OF
LOADING, LIMITED WAITING PARKING PLACES AND DISABLED
PARKING PLACES) ORDER 202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 20 January 2023 and 17 February 2023, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

1. Amend Schedule 1b) – Revocation as follows:
 - a) Insert Items (199a)(i), (199a)(ii), (199b) and (199c)(i) of Schedule 10.01;
 - b) Insert items (19a)(i) and (19a)(ii) of Schedule 13.01.
2. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Fishergate Phase 2, Various Roads, Preston, Preston City) (Revocation and Various Parking Restrictions) Order 2016" insofar as it relates to:
 - a) Schedule 6;
 - b) Schedule 9;
 - c) Item v) of Schedule 13;
 - d) Item b) of Schedule 16;
 - e) Schedule 21.
3. Amend Schedule 2 – Prohibition of Waiting to insert the following:
 - a) Guildhall Street, Preston, the east side, from its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 16.5 metres in a northerly direction;
 - b) Guildhall Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 53.5 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 28.5 metres in a northerly direction;
 - c) Guildhall Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 106 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 40.5 metres in a northerly direction;
 - d) Guildhall Street, Preston, the west side, from its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 146.5 metres in a northerly direction.
4. Amend Schedule 3 - Prohibition of Loading and Unloading to insert the following:
 - a) Guildhall Street, Preston, the east side, from its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 16.5 metres in a northerly direction;
 - b) Guildhall Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 53.5 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 28.5 metres in a northerly direction;
 - c) Guildhall Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 106 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 40.5 metres in a northerly direction;
 - d) Guildhall Street, Preston, the west side, from its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 82 metres in a northerly direction.
5. Amend Schedule 7 – Restriction of Waiting Monday to Saturday 8am – 6:30pm as follows:
 - a) Remove Item a) Cross Street;
 - b) Insert the following:
 - i) Cross Street, Preston, the south side, from a point 14 metres east of its junction with the centreline of Avenham Road to a point 29 metres west of its junction with the centreline of Chaddock Street;
 - ii) Guildhall Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 121.5 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 25 metres in a northerly direction.
6. Introduce a disabled persons parking place between 7am and 7pm in Guildhall Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 82 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 24 metres in a northerly direction.
7. Introduce a taxi stand between 7pm and midnight and midnight and 7am in Guildhall Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 82 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 24 metres in a northerly direction.
8. Introduce a restriction of loading/unloading Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6:30pm in Guildhall Street, Preston, the east side, from a point 121.5 metres north of its junction with the centreline of Cross Street for a distance of 25 metres in a northerly direction.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of these modifications are to add a section of No Waiting and No Loading at Any Time restrictions on Guildhall Street and extend the current Restriction of Waiting on Cross Street across from the private parking areas to allow sufficient manoeuvring space for vehicles to gain access to and from the parking area.

The modification further tidies up and clarifies the current Orders on Guildhall Street with no material change to the restrictions or their extents.
