NOTICE OF MODIFICATION ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, PRESTON CITY AREA) (REVOCATION, PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, PROHIBITION OF LOADING, LIMITED WAITING PARKING PLACES AND DISABLED PARKING PLACES) ORDER 202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 20 January 2023 and 17 February 2023, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

- 1. Amend Schedule 2 Prohibition of Waiting as follows:
 - a) Remove Items zzzz) Hind Street and ccccc) Hind Street;
 - b) Insert Hind Street, Preston, both sides, from a point 70.5 metres south west of its junction with the centreline of Grafton Street to its junction with the centreline of South Meadow Lane.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this modification is to reduce the length of proposed Prohibition of Waiting on the north side of Hind Street to allow for additional parking spaces whilst still maintaining the restrictions where road safety may be compromised.
