

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LANCASTER AND PRESTON CITY)
(AMENDMENT TO PERMIT PARKING PROVISIONS) ORDER 202*



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 45 and 46 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 20 January 2023 and 17 February 2023, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

Amend Schedule 13 to include a 2 hour tariff for Avenham Street, Camden Place, Charnley Street, Cross Street, Garden Street, Guildhall Street, Mount Street, St Wilfred Street, Winckley Square.
The amendment will appear as shown below.

Statement of Reasons

The purpose of this modification is to introduce a 2 Hour Tariff to the Preston City Centre Pay and Display following objections and feedback in relation to the formal consultation to introduce Sunday charges.

This proposal will facilitate short stay parking provisions for visitors to the city centre and a sufficient time period for people to practice their religion at the number of places of worship around the city centre whilst not impeding on the long stay parking provisions provided by the city centre car parks.
