THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SNAPE GREEN AND VARIOUS ROADS, SCARISBRICK, WEST LANCASHIRE DISTRICT) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER, 1997.

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Snape Green and Various Roads, Scarisbrick, West Lancashire District) (40mph Speed Limit) Order, 1997 and shall come into force on the 26th August, 1997.
