THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SNODWORTH ROAD, LANGHO, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH) (REVOCATION AND RESTRICTED ROAD) ORDER, 1998.

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- The Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Langho, Ribble Valley Borough) (30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order, 1990, is hereby revoked in so far as it relates to the 40mph speed limit along the length of road specified in Article 2 to this Order.
- 2. The length of Snodworth Road, Langho, from its junction with York Road for a distance of 570 metres in a northerly direction shall be a restricted road for the purposes of Section 81 of the Act.
- 3. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Snodworth Road, Langho, Ribble Valley Borough) (Revocation and Restricted Road) Order 1998 and shall come into force on the 14th December, 1998.
