
**THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(THE FARTHINGS AREA ZONE, ASTLEY VILLAGE, CHORLEY BOROUGH)
(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2001**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1)(a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. For the purpose of this Order "The Farthings Area Zone Boundary" means the Boundary as defined in Schedule 2 to this Order.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20mph on any of the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order and situated inside The Farthings Area Zone Boundary.
3. This Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (The Farthings Area Zone, Astley Village, Chorley Borough) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2001 and shall come into force on the 27th June 2001.

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Schedule 1 20mph speed limit on the following lengths of roads within The Farthings Area Zone Boundary (full length unless otherwise stated):-

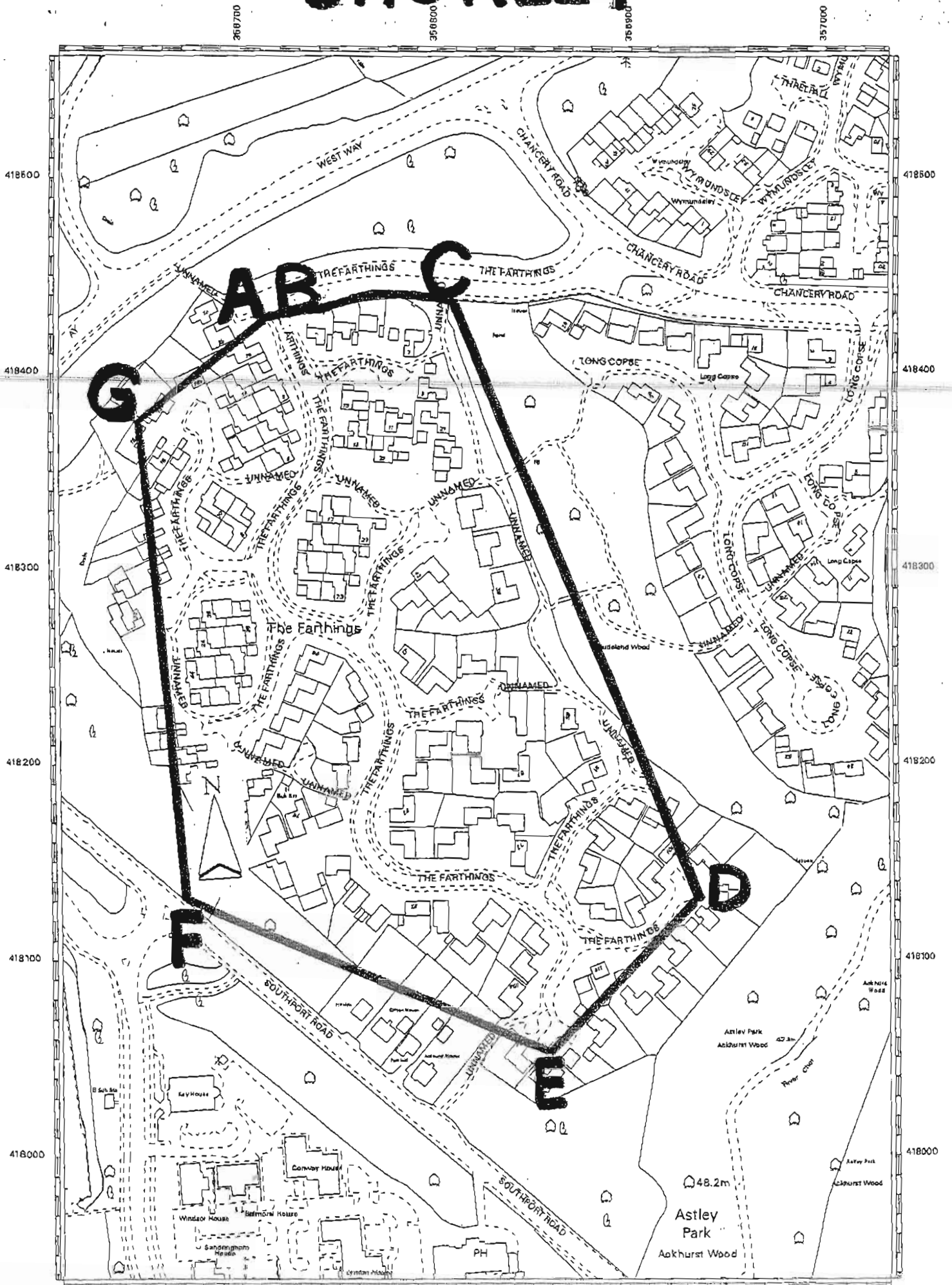
The Farthings
The unnamed road along the easternmost side of the zone
The unnamed road in the westernmost section of the zone

Schedule 2 Description of The Farthings Area Zone Boundary:-

- 1) From Point A along the southerly highway boundary of the northernmost length of The Farthings to Point B. Point A is where the south-western highway boundary of The Farthings meets the southerly highway boundary of the northernmost length of The Farthings. Point B is where the north-eastern highway boundary of the northernmost length of The Farthings meets the southerly highway boundary of the northernmost length of The Farthings.

- 2) From Point B along the southerly highway boundary of The Farthings to Point C. Point C is where the southerly highway boundary of the northernmost length of The Farthings meets the easterly highway boundary of the easternmost unnamed road.
- 3) From Point C along a straight line to Point D. Point D is on the south corner of the easternmost turning area of The Farthings.
- 4) From Point D along a straight line to Point E. Point E is on the east corner of the south-west leg of the southernmost turning area of The Farthings.
- 5) From Point E along a straight line to Point F. Point F is where the extended centre line of Foxhole Road meets the north-eastern highway boundary of Southport Road.
- 6) From Point F for 245 metres in a northerly direction to Point G.
- 7) From Point G along a straight line for 86 metres to Point A.
