ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1967

THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (RESTRICTED ROADS) (NO. 1) ORDER 1981.

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 72(3) and 73(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968 and Schedule 19 of the Local Government Act 1972 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1967") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for Lancashire hereby Order as follows:-

- 1. It is directed that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purpose of Section 71 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Lancashire County Council (Restricted Roads) (No. 1) Order 1981 and shall come into operation on the 9th March, 1981.

Lengths of road at Heapey and Wheelton, Chorley Borough

- That length of Town Lane, Heapey, from a point 175 metres (191 yards) west of its junction with Blackburn Road to that junction.
- ii) That length of Blackburn Road, Wheelton, from its junction with Town Lane to its junction with the A.674 Wheelton By-Pass and Victoria Street.
- iii) That length of Victoria Street, Wheelton, from its junction with Blackburn Road to its junction with the A.674 Wheelton By-Pass.
