THE LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(VARIOUS ROADS, LANGHO, RIBLE VALLEY BOROUGH) (30 MPH AND 40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1990

The Lancashire County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) (2) and (3) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

- The County Council of Lancaster (40 mph Speed Limit) (No 6) Order 1972 is hereby revoked.
- 2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on any of the lengths of road specified in Scedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on either of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. The Order may be cited as "The Lancashire County Council (Various roads, Langho, Ribble Valley Borough) (30 and 40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1990", and shall come into operation on 11th June, 1990.

SCHEDULE 1

LENGTHS OF ROAD AT LANGHO, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH

- 1. York Lane, York, between Whalley Old Road and its junction with Snodworth Road/Whinney Lane;
- 2. Snodworth Road between a point 100 metres south of the south gable wall of house Meadow's End and its junction with York Lane.

SCHEDULE 2

LENGTHS OF ROAD AT LANGHO, RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH

- 1. Whalley Old Road and York Road, York between points 20 metres southwest of the junction of York Road with Snodworth Road and 100 metres northeast of the junction of Whalley Old Road with York Lane;
- .2. Snodworth Road between its junction with York road and a point 100 metres south of the south gable wall of house Meadow's End.
