


# PSHE SLA Summer Newsletter

### **NEW PSHE COURSES:**

There has been a large increase in schools seeking support for children on how to deal with toxic influences within the media. In our course programme next year, myself and consultant Nigel Kirkham will be delivering a course (primary focused to begin with) that focuses this.

This course will be run throughout the year and will provide guidance on how you can support children overcome these negative influences and address these in school in an age-appropriate way.

I will also be running a series of online updates to share a summary of the subject review when this is published. I will run these on a monthly basis to allow the best chance for you to attend one and find out more about what the review means for you.



### **RSE Day!**

RSE is a national event which runs on the last Thursday in June each year.
