QUEEN VICTORIA ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Queen Victoria Road, Burnley from its junction with Briercliffe Road to outside of 2 Queen Victoria Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative from 0001 hours on Tuesday 27th June 2023 until 2359 hours on Wednesday 1st January 2025 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. A diversion will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to close the area around the collapsed building at 189 Briercliffe Road and allow repair works to be carried out.
