

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(LONGMEANYGATE AND MIDGE HALL LANE, LEYLAND, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)
(40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2016**

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Section 84 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. 40mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph along the lengths of road set out in the schedule to this Order.

2. Exemption

No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those Regulations.

3. Commencement of Order

This Order shall come into force on the 7th day of March 2016 and may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Longmeanygate And Midge Hall Lane, Leyland, South Ribble Borough) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2016".

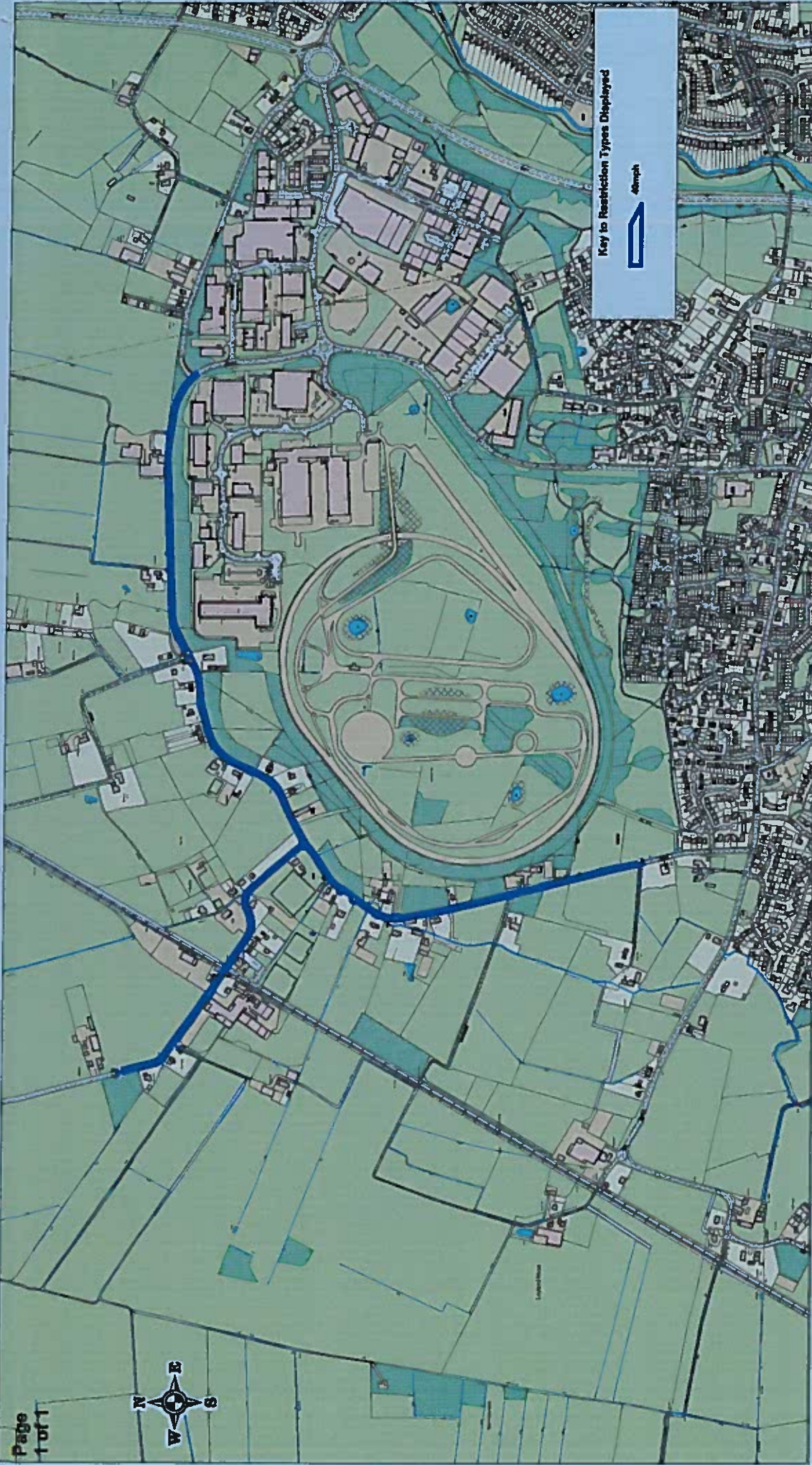

1. Longmeanygate, from a point 70 metres north of the centreline of Marathon Place to a point 135 metres north of the centreline of The Laund.
2. Midge Hall Lane, from its junction with Longmeanygate to a point 617 metres north-west of the centreline of Longmeanygate
