

PROPOSED SHARED USE CYCLE WAY
BLACKPOOL ROAD, KIRKHAM, FYLDE BOROUGH



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that in accordance with Section 65(1) and 66(4) of the Highways Act 1980 Lancashire County Council propose to convert the following lengths of footway to joint use cycleways:-

From the west side of Kirkham Bypass (A585) exiting on Blackpool Road (A583) and passing through the wooded area down to the existing path which runs underneath the existing bridge that carries Kirkham Bypass (A585), then continuing along the existing path through to Ribby Road. The route will make use of the existing path from the school playing fields on the west side of Kirkham Bypass (A585) through to Ribby Road on the east side of Kirkham Bypass (A585). The path will be amended and upgraded as necessary.



Statement of Reasons

The purpose of these proposals are to provide a shared use path allowing pedestrians and cycles to safely travel from the west side of the A585 to the east side. This will improve and encourage sustainable transport in and between local residential areas, employment, and recreation.
