(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Fall Kirk, Gressingham from its junction with Fleet Lane to its Junction with B6254 Kirkby Lonsdale Road.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0745 hours on Monday 18th March 2024 until 1545 hours on Friday 3rd May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Gressingham Road – A683 Melling Road v- A683 Tunstall Road – A683 Burrow Road – into Cumbria – B6254 Robraine – B6254 Church Street to Robraine – B6524 Main Street – B6254 Kirkby Lonsdale Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow works to repair land slip to be carried out.
