HALSTEAD STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Halstead Street, Burnley from its junction with Manchester Road to its junction with Thorney Bank Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0830 hours on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> January 2024 until 1730 hours on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. Access to the train station carpark will remain accessible via Dent Row.
- 5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Dent Row – Trafalgar Street – Manchester Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to carry out major carriageway and footway improvements at the junction to be carried out.
