## NOTICE OF PROPOSAL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(BRIDGE STREET, CHURCH STREET, HIGH STREET AND MARKET PLACE, GARSTANG, WYRE BOROUGH) (REVOCATION, PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND LIMITED WAITING PARKING PLACE) ORDER 202\*

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984,** as amended, the effect of which will be to:

- Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Garstang, Wyre Borough) (Part Revocation, Prohibition of Waiting, Restriction of Waiting and Restriction of Loading/Unloading) Order 2011" insofar as it relates to:
  - a) Items e), f) and g) of Schedule 2;
  - b) Items h) and f) of Schedule 3;
  - c) Item b) of Schedule 6.
- 2. Introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:
  - a) Bridge Street, Garstang, the north east side, from a point 40.5 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Coach House Mews to a point 28 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Park Hill Road;
  - b) Bridge Street, Garstang, the north east side, from a point 10 metres north west of its junction with the centreline of Coach House Mews for a distance of 31 metres in a south easterly direction;
  - c) High Street, Garstang, the west side, from its junction with the centreline of Croston Road for a distance of 60.5 metres in a southerly direction.
- 3. Introduce a restriction of waiting Monday to Saturday between 8am and 6pm in the following lengths of road:
  - a) Church Street. Garstang, the north west side, from its junction with the centreline of Market Place for a distance of 13 metres in a south westerly direction;
  - b) High Street, Garstang, the west side, from a point 60.5 metres south of its junction with the centreline of Croston Road to its junction with the centreline of Market Place:
  - c) Market Place, Garstang, the north west side, from its junction with the centreline of High Street to its junction with the centreline of Church Street.
- 4. Introduce a limited waiting parking place for 30 minutes with no return within 30 minutes Monday to Saturday 8am to 6pm in Bridge Street, Garstang, the north east side, from a point 23 metres south east of its junction with the centreline of Coach House Mews for a distance of 17.5 metres in a south easterly direction.
