

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CAMBRIDGE DRIVE AND WINDSOR ROAD, OSWALDTWISTLE,
HYNDBURN BOROUGH) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- a) Cambridge Drive, Oswaldtwistle, the south side, from its junction with the centreline of Windsor Road for a distance of 26.5 metres in a westerly direction;
- b) Windsor Road, Knuzden Brook, Oswaldtwistle, the west side, from its junction with the centreline of Cambridge Drive for a distance of 31 metres in a southerly direction.
