

NOTICE OF MODIFICATION
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(CORPORATION STREET AREA, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)
(REVOCATIONS AND VARIOUS MOVING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council proposed to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended. Following consultation carried out between 04 November 2022 and 02 December 2022, it is now intended to modify the proposed Order as titled above, as set out below.

Remove Item b) from Schedule 3. One Way Traffic on Bowran Street, Preston, from Marsh Lane to Mount Pleasant north to south.



Statement of Reasons

Having considered recent additional feedback from the businesses on Bowran Street and Heatley Street, it is now proposed to make the above modification to the consulted proposals to improve access to their businesses. The modification will maintain the current 2-way traffic on Bowran Street allowing vehicles to continue to exit onto Marsh Lane.
