(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Tootell Street and Collingwood Road, Chorley from its junction with Pall Mall to its junction with Hornchurch Drive.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1800 hours on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2024 until Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access to be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Moorhead Road – Yarrow Valley Way – Copperwood Way  
Stanstead Road – Collingwood Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by LCC Highways.
