ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SPEED LIMIT MANAGEMENT)(VARIOUS ROADS, LANCASTER CITY AREA) (PART REVOCATION, 30, 40, 50 AND 60 MPH SPEED LIMIT)(NO 1) ORDER 2010

The County Council of Lancashire, in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1)(a) and (2) of and Part 1V of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Part Revocation

- a) Those parts of the Orders specified in Schedule 1 to this Order are hereby revoked.
- b) The Speed restrictions in Articles 2, 3 and 4 to this Order will reduce the National Speed Limit where appropriate.

2. 30mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour along any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

3. 40mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour along any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.

4. 50mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour along any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.

5. 60mph Speed Limit

No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 60 miles per hour along any of the lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 to this Order.

6. Commencement of Order

This Order may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council (Speed Limit Management)(Various Roads, Lancaster City Area)(Part Revocation, 30, 40 50 and 60 mph Speed Limit)(No 1)Order 2010" and shall come into force on the 20th September, 2010.
