(PRIMROSE HILL, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Primrose Hill, Preston from its junction with London Road to its junction with Adelaide Street.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative nightly from 1900 hours until 0600 hours on 18th March 2024 until 27th March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

London Road – New Hall Lane – Adelaide Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Galliford Try to install signage to the college building.
