(CROPPER ROAD & WHITEHILL ROAD, WESTBY WITH PLUMPTONS, FYLDE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of highway in the Borough of Fylde:
 - i. Cropper Road from the roundabout junction of B5410 Lytham St Annes Way to the roundabout junction of A5230 Progress Way.
 - ii. Whitehill Road from its junction with Preston New Road to the roundabout junction of B5410.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibitions will be operative from 0730 hours on Monday 19th February 2024 until 1600 hours on Friday 29th March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Cropper Road: Progress Way – Midgeland Road – School Road **Whitehill Road**: Preston New Road – Lytham St Annes Way

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow reconstruction of the roundabout to accommodate the M55 Heyhouses Scheme to be carried out by LCC Highways.
