DEARDENGATE, HASLINGDEN, ROSSENDALE BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Deardengate, Haslingden from its junction with Bury Road to its junction with Manchester Road.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0730 hours on Thursday 15th February 2024 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 6th March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Pedestrian access to premises on or adjacent to the road will not be prohibited by any provision of this order.
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Bury Road – Manchester Road.

And also:

Blackburn Road – John Street – Regent Street – Bury Road.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow trial hole excavation to be carried out for the Haslingden Town Centre Regeneration project.
