- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 2nd April 2024 until 1800 hours on Monday 8th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible Pedestrian access to premises on or adjacent to the road will not be prohibited by any provision of this order
- An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Cross Edge – Broadfield – Haslingden Road – Roundhill Road – Blackburn Road – Manchester Road – Eastgate – King Street – Blackburn
