WILLOWS LANE, ACCRINGTON, HYNDBURN BOROUGH
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of Willows Lane, Accrington from outside number 198 Willows Lane to outside number 204 Willows Lane, Accrington.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 2nd April 2024 until 1800 hours on Monday 8th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible
Pedestrian access to premises on or adjacent to the road will not be prohibited by any provision of this order
5. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-
Cross Edge – Broadfield – Haslingden Road – Roundhill Road –
Blackburn Road – Manchester Road – Eastgate – King Street –
Blackburn

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow water hydrant works to be carried out on behalf of United Utilities
