(BLUE MOOR ROAD, TREALES ROSEACRE AND WHARLES, FYLDE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Blue Moor Road, Treales Roseacre and Wharles from its junction with Church Road to its junction with Salwick Road.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 8th April 2024 until 1800 hours on Friday 14th June 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible. However, please note that motor vehicles will not be permitted across the bridge.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Salwick Road – Inskip Road – Church Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow the full deck refurbishment of Blue Moor Road Overbridge to be carried out by National Highways.
