NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, or a Civil Enforcement Officer, cause or permit any Vehicle to wait or wait for the purposes of Loading or Unloading in the lengths of road set out in Article:
- I. Albyn Bank Road, Preston South side From a point outside property No75 for a distance of 77 Metres to its junction with Carr Street.
- II. Carr Street, Preston North East side From its junction with Albyn Bank Road for a Distance of 44 Metres to its junction with Lark Hill Street.
- III. Arno Street, Preston North side from its Junction with Manchester Road for 31 metres.
- IV. Tiber Street, Preston on both side of the carriageway at its Junction with Arno Street for a distance of 10 meters either side of the junction.
 - 2. The restrictions will be operative daily from 0800 hours to 1700 hours from Monday to Friday inclusively between the dates from 12th February 2024 until 31st January 2025 or until it is deemed the prohibition is no longer required.

The temporary restrictions are necessary to allow J Greenwood Builders Ltd to carry out building development works on Cardinal Newman College.
