- 1. Revoke the "Lancashire County Council (Various Roads, Chorley, Fylde, Hyndburn, Preston, Ribble Valley, Rossendale and West Lancashire) (Revocation, 20mph, 30mph, 40mph and 50mph Speed Limits December (No1)) Order 2019" insofar as it relates to Item a) of Schedule 3.
- 2. Introduce a 20mph Speed Limit in the following lengths of road:
 - a) Back Lane, Rising Bridge, from its junction with Back Lane, Baxenden, to a point 40 metres north west of Hazel Street;
 - b) Back Lane, Baxenden, from a point 172 metres south east of its junction with Partridge Drive, to its junction with Back Lane, Rising Bridge.
