(DIVISION LANE, LYTHAM ST ANNES, FYLDE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Division Lane, Lytham St Annes from its junction with Queensway to the sub-station adjacent to the property "Homestead".
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Tuesday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2024 until 1700 hours on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Common Edge Road – Progress Way – Midgeland Road – Division Lane and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow cable installation works for a new supply to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of ENW.
