ASHFIELD ROAD, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Ashfield Road, Burnley from its junction with Calder Vale Road to approximately 20 metres eastbound.
2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative nightly from 22:00 hours until 06:00 hours from Monday 4th March 2024 until Friday 8th March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Ashfield Road – Royle Road – Calder Vale Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow vegetation management works to be carried out.
