NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Ashfield Road, Burnley from its junction with Calder Vale Road to approximately 20 metres eastbound.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative nightly from 22:00 hours until 06:00 hours from Monday 4th March 2024 until Friday 8th March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Ashfield Road - Royle Road - Calder Vale Road and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow vegetation management works to be carried out.
