NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U477
 Deans Lane, Newburgh from property number 37 to a point 40m South of
 Deans Lane Level Crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative on the dates as per the below schedule:
 - i. From 2330 hours on Sunday 17th March 2024 until 0630 hours on Saturday 23rd March 2024.
 - ii. Nightly from 2330 hours and 0630 hours between Tuesday 2nd April 2024 until Thursday 4th April 2024.
 - iii. Nightly from 2330 hours and 0630 hours between Wednesday 17th April 2024 until Friday 19th April 2024.

or until completion of the works within this period.

4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closures is via:-

C164 Hoscar Moss Road, Ivy House Farm – C164 Ring O Bells Lane, Lathom – A5209 Briars Lane, Lathom – A5209 Lowry Hill Lane, Lathom – A5209 Course Lane, Newburgh – U472 Back Lane, Newburgh and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow plain line track renewal and follow up works at the level crossing to be carried out by Centurion Site Services on behalf of Network Rail.
