(MARSH LANE, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Marsh Lane, Preston from a point at Marsh Lane railway bridge travelling in either direction for approximately 20 metres.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative overnight from 2200 hours on 29<sup>th</sup> April 2024 until 0600 hours on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Marsh Lane – Ring Way - Corporation Street – Leighton Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Network Rail to carry out bridge examination work.
