(BRINDLE ROAD, BAMBER BRIDGE, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Brindle Road, Bamber Bridge from 20 metres either side of the level crossing.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative overnight from 2300 hours on Saturday 23rd March 2024 until 0600 hours on Sunday 24th March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access to be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Brindle Road – School Lane – B6258 – A6 – Four Oaks Road – Tramway Lane – Kellet Lane and Vice Versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow annual level crossing testing works to be carried out by Network Rail.
