(LONG MOSS LANE, WHITESTAKE, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Long Moss Lane, Whitestake from its junction with Moss Lane for 60 metres in an easterly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1000 hours until 1500 hours on Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2024 until completion of the works within this period. Access to be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Gill Lane - Land Lane - Drumacre Lane East - Brownhill Lane - Chapel Lane - Moss Lane - High Burn Lane - Wham Lane And Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow vegetation management works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity Northwest.
