(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over the following lengths of road in the Borough of Wyre:
 - Lancaster Road from its junction with Rawcliffe Road for approximately 1270 metres in a northerly direction; and
 - ii. Rawcliffe Road from its junction with Lancaster Road for approximately 200 metres in a westerly direction.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative daily from 0930 hours to 1530 hours on Wednesday 10th April 2024 until Friday 12th April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Rawcliffe Road – Whin Lane – Bull Park Lane – Bradshaw Lane – Lancaster Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow safe access to the underground structure for cabling and jointing works to be carried out by BT Openreach.
