MARSH WAY, PENWORTHAM, SOUTH RIBBLE BOROUGH)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

1. No person shall cause any pedestrian or cycle to proceed over that length of footway on Marsh Way, Penwortham from its boundary with house number 1 for 10 metres in either direction.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on Monday 25th March 2024 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 3rd April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access to be maintained wherever and whenever possible.
4. A diversion for pedestrians and cycles will be signed locally.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow new cable connection works to be carried out by Network Plus on behalf of Electricity Northwest.
