(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

1. No person shall cause any class of traffic to proceed over that length of Miller Street, Preston from a point outside Sika House travelling in either direction for approximately 10 metres.
2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
3. The prohibition will be operative from 0900 hours on 6th March 2024 until 2359 hours on 10th March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
4. A diversion is not available at this location.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow urgent sewer repair works to be carried out.
