ST JAMESS STREET, BURNLEY, BURNLEY BOROUGH (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of St James's Street, Burnley from its junction with Parker Lane to its junction with St James's Row.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1630 hours until 2330 hours on Sunday 24th March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

St James's Row – Bull Street – Manchester Road – Parker Lane and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow crane works around the shopping centre complex to be carried out.
