**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any class of vehicle to proceed over that length of Riding Barn Street, Church from its junction with Hyndburn Road to its junction of Elmfield Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0930 to 1500 hours on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2024 or until completion of the works within this period
- 4. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible Pedestrian access to premises on or adjacent to the road will not be prohibited by any provision of this order
- 5 An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Buckingham Grove – Manor Place – Hyndburn Road and vice versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow pole replacement works to be carried out on behalf of Morrison Telecom Service
