(HENRIETTA STREET, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Henrietta Street, Preston from a point outside the Electricity Sub Station travelling in a north westerly direction to a point at the rear of 27 St Marys Street.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0000 hours on 8th April 2024 until 2359 hours on 26th July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via: -

Henrietta Street – St Marys Street – Henrietta Street

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow Electricity North West to carry out substation replacement works.
