(U591 FIRSWOOD ROAD, LATHOM, WEST LANCASHIRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council have made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of U591 Firswood Road, Lathom from C160 Spa Lane, Lathom to X162 Slate Lane, Lathom.
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2024 until 1700 hours on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **Residents access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

C160 Spa Lane, Lathom – U577 Statham Road, Skelmersdale – U577 Stanley Way, Skelmersdale – A577 Neverstitch Road, Skelmersdale – A577 Ormskirk Road, Blaguegate – A577 Blaguegate Lane, Lathom and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow high voltage connection works to be carried out by PN Daly for Bellway Homes Development.
