(BACK LANE, CLAYTON-LE-WOODS, CHORLEY BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) NOTICE 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council consider it necessary or expedient by reason of works being executed on the following length of road that the prohibition should come into force without delay under **Section 14(2)(a)** of the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, which will temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle or cycle to proceed over that length of Back Lane, Clayton-le-Woods from Hill Croft, Clayton-le-Woods to a point approximately 60m East of Cravers Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this notice shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 1005 hours on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2024 until 1600 hours on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> March 2024 or until completion of the works within this period. **Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.**
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-

Back Lane, Clayton-le-Woods – Wood End Road, Clayton-le-Woods – B5256 Clayton Green Road, Clayton-le-Woods – B5256 Sheep Hill Brow, Clayton-le-Woods – Back Lane, Clayton-le-Woods and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow emergency drainage works to be carried out by Lancashire County Council.
