ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BENTHAM ROAD, COLLINGHAM ROAD AND WHINFELL DRIVE,
LANCASTER, LANCASTER CITY) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER
202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lancashire County Council propose to make the above Traffic Regulation Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 to the **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to introduce a prohibition of waiting in the following lengths of road:

- a) Bentham Road, Lancaster, the north side, from its junction with the centreline of Whinfell Drive for a distance of 20 metres in a north easterly direction;
- b) Collingham Park, Lancaster, the north side, from its junction with the centreline of Whinfell Drive for a distance of 21 metres in a westerly direction;
- c) Whinfell Drive, Lancaster, both sides, from its junction with the centreline of Collingham Park/Bentham Road, for a distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction.
