QUEENSWAY (B6478), CLITHEROE, RIBBLE VALLEY (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1)** (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this notice.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle, cycle or pedestrian to proceed over that length of Queensway (B6478), Clitheroe from its junction with Whalley Road to its junction with Queensway (A671).
- 2. Nothing in this order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- 3. The prohibition will be operative from 0800 hours on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2024 until 1700 hours on Wednesday 31<sup>st</sup> July 2024 or until completion of the works within this period.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:-Whalley Road – Queensway (A671) and vice versa.

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow a site compound for regeneration works at Castle Street.
