(WHINNEY BROW LANE, FORTON, WYRE BOROUGH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lancashire County Council has made an Order under **Section 14(1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit traffic on the roads set out in this Order.

- 1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed over that length of Whinney Brow Lane, Forton from its junction with Lancaster Road to its boundary with Brookland Farm.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to persons engaged in the carrying out of the works.
- The prohibition will be operative nightly from 2100 hours to 0600 hours on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2024 until Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> May 2024 hours or until completion of the works within this period. Access will be maintained whenever and wherever possible.
- 4. An alternative route for vehicular traffic affected by the closure is via:

Hollins Lane – Lancaster Road – Vice Versa

The temporary prohibition is necessary to allow underground structure works to be carried out by Sunbelt Rentals Ltd on behalf of BT Openreach.
